Required Documents to Bring

- Photo ID
- Social Security Cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) Letters
- 1095-A
- Bank account number and routing number for direct deposit
- *Prior Year Tax Return(s) are recommended for Tax Year 2024, if filed - 2023 and 2022 are also acceptable*

Income and Adjustment/Deduction Statements

- W2 - Wages
- 1099-INT/1099-DIV - Interest/Dividends
- 1099-R - Retirement income
- SSA-1099, RRB-1099 - Social Security or Railroad Retirement Benefits
- UC 1099-G - Unemployment Compensation
- 1099-G - Refund of state/local income taxes
- 1099-MISC, 1099-NEC, 1099-K - Self Employment
- 1099-B - Income (or loss) from the sale or exchange of stocks, bonds, digital assets or real estate income (or loss) from rental property
- **Other income documents** - gambling, lottery, prizes, awards, jury duty, digital assets, Sch K-1, royalties, foreign income, etc.
- 1098-E - Student loan interest payments
- **Medical & Dental Expenses** (including insurance premiums)
- **Form 1098** - Mortgage Interest
